Zhang Guang-Yu is currently based in Shanghai, China. He first studied fine art at the China Central Academy of Fine Arts, Beijing, China, and in 2012 received his BFA from Central Saint Martin's College of Arts and Design, London.

He had recognised as a strong emerging artist by Saatchi Art, and presented him into the 'One to Watch' list. He was a finalist in the ArtGemini Prize exhibition in 2013 at London's Rebecca Hossack Gallery, and was selected for the international emerging artists exhibition "Continental Shift" at the Saatchi Gallery in April, 2014. Furthermore, his works are displayed in the digital screens at Tate Britain in London in August, 2014.
